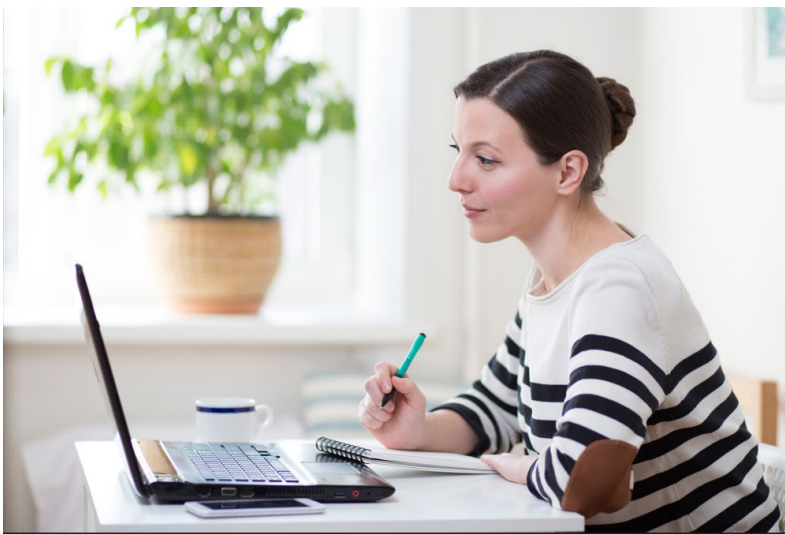


Domestic Violence Advocacy Training
