Session 1 (March 11): Stressors on Populations Impacted by Domestic Violence

Session 2 (March 12): Assessing Risk

Identifying cases in greater need of intervention, understanding the context and severity of violence including strangulation and traumatic brain injuries

Session 3 (March 13): Legal Issues Related to Domestic Violence

Abuse Prevention Orders, Harassment Orders, DV in the Probate Court, and child custody considerations
